Dear Peter,

Please find enclosed the updated documents we received on March 04. These replace the annexes 1 and 3 to the initial project proposal of October 9 (also in the EN version you should have). We also got a text on 16 March which is meant to be the "annex 1 to the STCs" cited in the annex 2 to the project proposal (cf. page 23 of the project proposal; i.e. an annex to the supplementary terms and conditions of the German TSOs):

*“Die Entgelthöchstgrenze des Leistungszeitraums bestimmt sich aus dem nach den regulatorischen Vorgaben gebildeten Kapazitätsentgelt ab dem 01.01.2022, multipliziert mit der Veränderung des vom Statistischen Bundesamt veröffentlichten Verbraucherpreisindex (Gesamtindex) für Deutschland (VPI) des Leistungszeitraums zu dem VPI des Jahres 2022, zuzüglich eines etwaigen Auktionsaufschlages und zzgl. eines etwaigen obligatorischen Mindestaufschlages.“*

*„The maximum charge limit of the delivery period is determined from the capacity charge formed in accordance with the regulatory requirements from 01.01.2022, multiplied by the change in the consumer price index (overall index) for Germany (CPI) published by the Federal Statistical Office for the performance period to the CPI of the year 2022, plus any auction surcharge and plus any mandatory minimum surcharge.“*

Please excuse my misunderstanding. With other NRAs we have proceeded in such a way that one NRA confirms completeness when it can decide on the basis of the documents present. So this can be a different time/different basis when the other NRA needs still more information because the situation/project implementation is different in its own jurisdiction.

The annexes 1 and 3 are different from the original ones, since *inter alia* the project proposal on the NL border will officially be taken back by the TSOs this week.
