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# Consideration of responses to the public consultation on the Amended FCR Cooperation TSO’s Proposal

## Introduction

FCR Cooperation TSOs are proposing a new *Amendment to the TSOs’ proposal for the establishment of common and harmonised rules and processes for the exchange and procurement of Balancing Capacity for Frequency Containment Reserves (FCR) in accordance with Article 33 of Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/2195 establishing a guideline on electricity balancing* (in this explanatory note, this document is referred to as the *Amended FCR Proposal*).

With this new amendment, TSOs are proposing a change to the TSO-TSO settlement mechanism. This change would not change the operations of the market or the way BSPs are remunerated, only the way TSOs remunerate TSOs for the import and export of FCR.

The FCR Cooperation organised a public consultation to collect stakeholders’ views on the change proposed in the Amended FCR Proposal. In this document, we would like to share the outcomes of this public consultation.

## Response(s) received

The FCR Cooperation received one response to its public consultation:

The FCR Cooperation TSOs will include the public consultation outcomes, together with the Amended FCR Proposal and explanatory note in the request to FCR Cooperation NRAs to approve the Amended FCR Proposal. Once approved, the FCR Cooperation will implement the changes described. The new TSO-TSO settlement methodology will be used from 01/01/2026.
